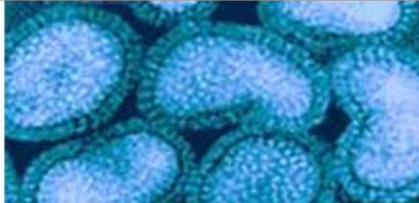
## Critical analysis of information
