Delphi study

Nomination and selection of participants:

- We received 268 potential respondents nominated by all EMIDA partners (except Cyprus)
- Selection based on agreed set of criteria
- We made a few adjustments suggested by Italy, Denmark, France and Netherlands
- Now we have 215 potential participants from 19 countries
- We are missing people from East Europe – Hungary, Bulgaria, Croatia, Slovenia, Slovakia, Romania, Ukraine, etc.
- We have until mid-October to find people from East Europe

Consensus workshop

- We start (FPU) our preparation of the consensus workshop end of December/beginning of January
- One of the first things we have to do is brainstorm on the contents of the workshop – which influences ideas on who we have to invite and what to do
- The FPU need more helping hands – volunteers namely from WP 4 to help us with preparation of the consensus workshop
- We need volunteers to be moderators of the several break-out sessions

Consensus workshop – continuing

- Progress made so far, there are time constraints finalising the two Delphi rounds
- To finalise the Delphi study before the consensus workshop will be hard – planned in April 2010 (month 24 of EMIDA - milestone) a week before Helsinki meeting
- We asked NMG yesterday for postponing the consensus workshop on the end of May or beginning of June
- NMG agreed with postponing of the Consensus workshop
